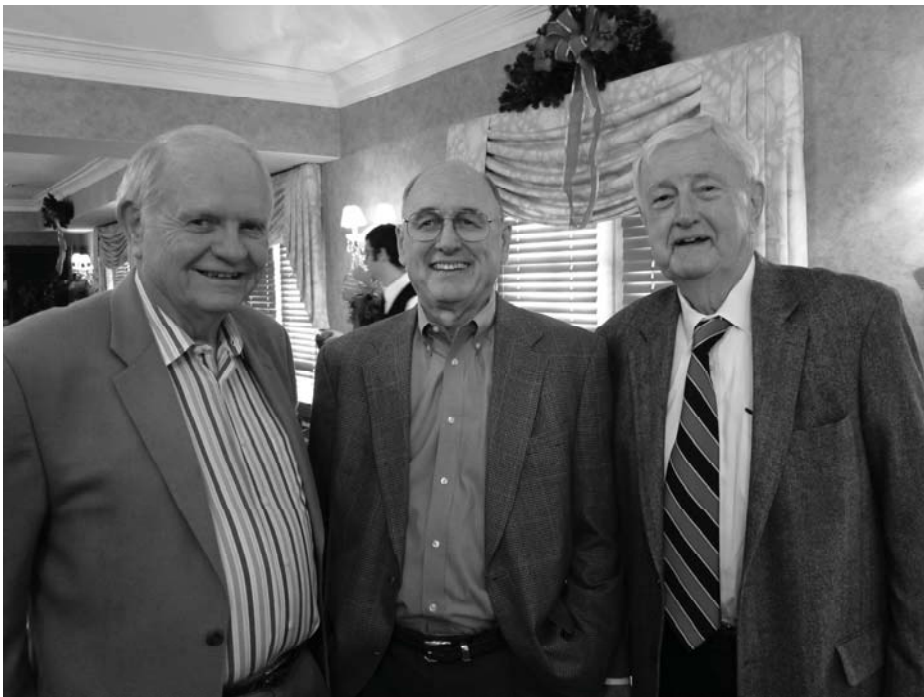

If you want to share your story, put it to pencil or just an outline and submit to the SIPES Newsletter Editor. We can turn it into gleaming prose.

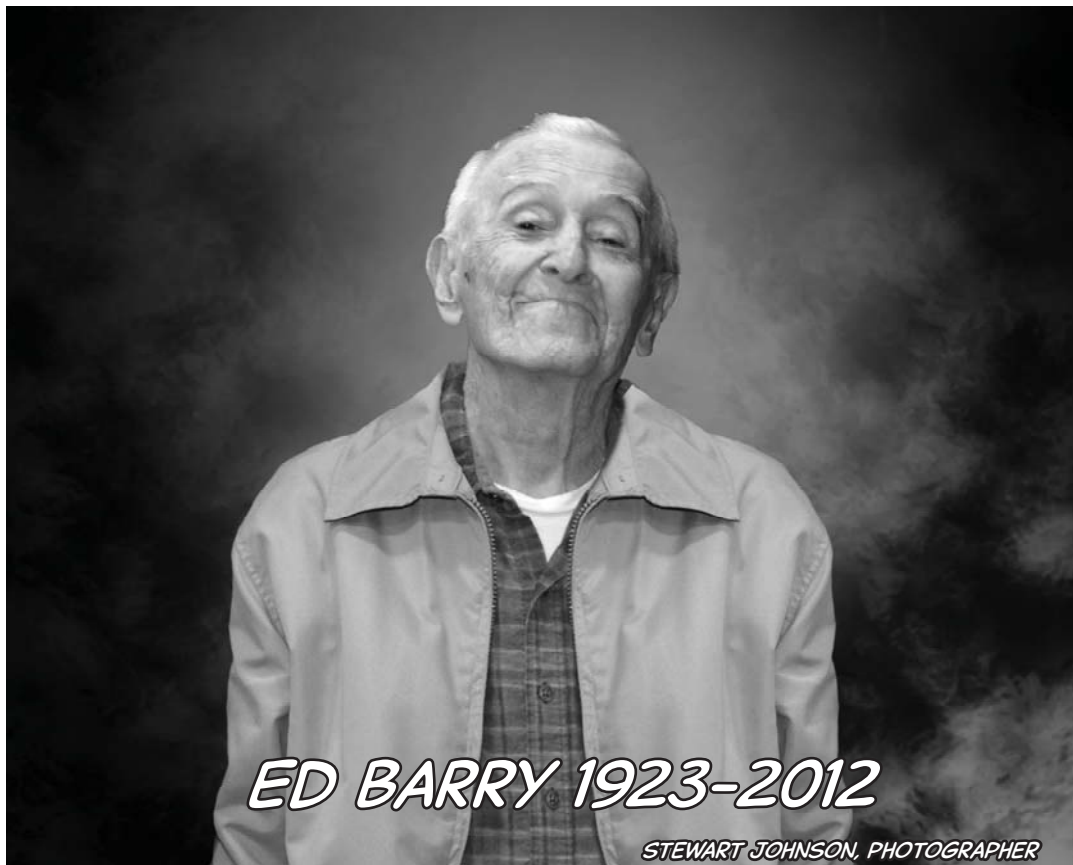
