

Proposed Lawsuit by Levee Boards Asking for Damages for Oil and Gas Companies.

Recently Levee Boards in the New Orleans area have proposed filing a lawsuit against all oil and gas companies that have ever drilled a well that required dredging in the state. Many of these companies are no longer in existence but we assume that their successor companies or anyone operating a well in the marsh land will be sued for damages. All of these wells were drilled in compliance with the regulations in force at the time they were drilled. Many were drilled when remediation was required by the state in areas that the state recommended for remediation. Many of these areas were not in the actual well site location.

The mere filing of this law suit would be detrimental to companies and energy professionals attempting to drill, operate and produce wells in Louisiana.

Gifford Briggs oversees the lobbying and governmental affairs for LOGA. He also directs the Political Action Committee of the Louisiana Oil and Gas Association (LOGPAC). In addition Briggs manages the website design, social media outreach, video production and the marketing identity of the Association. Briggs first joined LOGA (formerly LIOGA) in 1994 while attending college. He served as the Membership Coordinator and helped organize many firsts for LOGA, including the first annual meeting, Gulf Coast Prospect & Shale Expo, and board meetings. He later moved to Atlanta to pursue a career in restaurant management. He returned to LOGA in 2007. He is married to Jackie Wright, and the couple currently resides in Lafayette with their sons,

Gifford Ashley Briggs, Jr and Maxwell Wright Briggs. and their daughter, Chloe Lane Briggs.
