OUR MAY DINNER SPEAKER

A native of Fort Ord, California, Catherine Campanella's anomaly of birth was reconciled at the age of six weeks when her father was discharged from the Army and returned with his wife and two children to New Orleans. Just a few years later the family moved "way out" to a new suburb on the western edge of Metairie surrounded by large tracts of open land where blackberry picking and hiking through woods were childhood pastimes. Having grown up witnessing Metairie change and grow Cathy developed an interest in its history which is the subject of this new book.

An L.S.U. graduate with a B.A. in Fine Arts, Cathy chose a career in teaching (M. Ed., University of New Orleans) where she became a Technology Coordinator and early proponent of the educational value of the Internet. New Orleans History ~~ Lake Pontchartrain (www.pontchartrain.net) was her first attempt to compile a cultural overview as a pictorial history of the lake. Lake Pontchartrain (Arcadia Publishing, 2007) culminated this endeavor in a print edition. Now a retired educator, Cathy's interest in writing and research has grown to include Metairie (2008) an Images of America pictorial history also published by Arcadia.

Campanella has written for Scholastic Instructor, Read-Write-Think, and Every Day with Rachel Ray. Married to Mike Azzarello and the mother of two grown children, Cathy hopes her new book will not only provide reminders of times past but also increase awareness that Metairie's history is not only interwoven with that of the city of New Orleans but that each contributed to the other.

Our speaker will have copies of Metairie and Lake Pontchartrain available for signing after her talk. These books make ideal gifts for anyone interested in the culture and history of our area.


